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### **Town of Holden Board of Health Meeting – Remote Meeting December 15, 2020**

### **Approval of Meeting Minutes October 20, 2020 & November 10, 2020**

- Michael Mazloff made a motion to approve the November 10, 2020 meeting minutes, Michelle seconded the motion, Stella third. APPROVED

Michael Mazloff talked about the Wachusett Regional School District School Committee, they had invited the BOH to attend one of their meetings, and Michael agreed to go and asked the Board if they had anything they wanted him to bring to the meeting to let him know. Michael also talked about the Worcester Emergency Medical Reserve Corp which he is part of, he took a contact tracing training and said they are looking for more volunteers. He asked if the Alliance was doing the contact tracing for Holden. Pam answered yes, the state was behind so the Alliance is doing it themselves and using the school nurses for assistance.

Pam Harding talked about EDS – A drill was held December 5, 2020 – we had a good turnout with a very involved CERT Team, Emergency Preparedness Team, Fire and Police in Holden as well as Chris Montiverdi who has been a huge help through this. We focused on the COVID vaccine, social distancing, and worked on a flow chart for the gymnasium. We discussed a drive thru option but were not able to practice a physical drive thru due to the snow. Over all it went well.

Michael Mazloff discussed Mobil – another complaint came in from a resident who went in and witnessed contractors working in the store and not wearing masks. Danielle made a site visit and spoke to the owner.

Pam Harding discussed a complaint received from ABCC about Harvest Grille – They issued a warning due to the bartender wearing her mask around her chin and serving drinks at the bar with no Plexiglas installed at the bar. Danielle will follow up. There is also a cluster of COVID cases confirmed at InnerTite.
