

<u>Street Light Conversion Program – Update 1</u> March 2017

• The Light Department is the recipient of a grant from the State Department of Energy Resources (DOER) to facilitate the conversion of our street lights to LED.



- Various LED fixtures are being or have been installed on a section of Holden Street as part of our pilot program to see which lights will work best for us.
- There will be eight different fixtures from 4
 different suppliers, each with a letter
 designator upon the pole it's located (A H).
- Two models from each supplier, 4000K and 3000K, are being tested. These numbers refer

to the measurement of CCT – Correlated Color Temperature. The CCT is displayed in the "cool" or "warmth" of the light. The "cooler" models (4000k) have received a good deal of attention lately, especially from the American Medical Association.
