For the second year, the Holden Department of Public Works, Water & Sewer Division will be making its annual water quality report available to the public electronically through the Town's website. 

The annual water quality report, also known as the consumer confidence report, provides a summary of all contaminants found in Holden's drinking water during the previous year. It also provides information on water supply sources and treatment practices.



Preventing Stormwater Pollution

There is a big difference between a sanitary sewer and a storm drain.



Storm drain/Catch basin

The sanitary sewer system takes all wastewater from toilets, sinks and showers to a wastewater treatment facility, where the water is treated before it is discharged to a water body.

The storm drain system, on the other hand, collects rainwater from city streets and urban areas to prevent flooding.
