11. Marilyn brought up the possibility of a parade and this was discussed. No decision was made
12. Holly Nylander presented the idea of Civil War re-enactment. This would involve having to have people trained.
13. Jeremy reported that the Website will be up and running

14. If there is any money left after the celebration the Committee will give a gift back to the town possibly in the form of money toward the 300th celebration
15. The banner for the 250th will hang behind the Selectmen during the monthly meetings.
