Fire Damages Walnut Terrace Home

Fire severely damaged a single-family residence at 25 Walnut Terrace in Holden late Saturday. The fire, which was called in to the Wachusett Regional Communications Center at 11:37 PM, appears to have started in a second floor bedroom causing extensive damage to the interior of the home.

According to Holden Fire Chief Russ Hall, the first arriving units had heavy fire conditions on the second floor but made entry and quickly brought the fire under control. The home sustained extensive fire and smoke damage; four dogs and two cats in the house at the time of the fire were safely removed.

The Holden Fire Department was assisted by Rutland, Paxton and Sterling firefighters on scene while West Boylston provided station coverage. No injuries were reported and the fire remains under investigation.
