Fire Damages Fireside Lane Home

Fire severely damaged a condo unit at 105 Fireside Lane in Holden Sunday evening. The fire, which was called in to the Wachusett Regional Communications Center at 18:42 PM, appears to have started in the attic space from a possible lightning strike, causing extensive damage to the interior of the home.

According to Holden Fire Chief Russ Hall, the first arriving units had smoke and fire conditions in the attic and second floor of the unit. A working fire assignment was struck to bring mutual aid to the scene to assist Holden crews. The fire was brought under control and extinguished but the home sustained fire and smoke damage.

The Holden Fire Department was assisted by Rutland and Sterling firefighters on scene while Paxton, Leicester and West Boylston provided station coverage. During the fire, mutual aid companies responded to multiple 911 calls for service. Holden Police, HMLD, and representatives from the Building Department assisted at the scene. No injuries were reported and the fire remains under investigation.
