**Key Points:**

- Energy deliveries for February were 8.4% lower than February 2016 and 5.0% lower year to date. (February 2016 had one more day due to leap year.)
- On a degree-day basis, February was 10% warmer than 2016 and was 14% warmer than a normal February.
