





Connected Homes Program Adds Enel X JuiceBox EV Chargers

The HELPS Connected Homes Program, which leverages the technology of smart appliances and devices into cost savings for the light department and its customers, has expanded to include Enel X JuiceBox electric vehicle (EV) chargers.

Holden Municipal Light Department (HMLD) customers who own Enel X JuiceBox EV chargers can now enroll the chargers into the Connected Homes Program. By enrolling an EV charger, customers agree to allow Connected Homes to make brief, limited adjustments to their device during times of peak electric demand.

During times of peak electric demand, HMLD customers will be notified of an adjustment that will change the charging rate of their Enel X JuiceBox charger for a limited time. Customers will be notified of the change via email and given the option to opt out. Customers who participate will earn a \$10 monthly incentive that is paid out quarterly via incentive checks.
