DIRECTOR'S REPORT 7/23/2020

There is no update about opening to the public

ARIS and the FINANCIAL REPORT to the state are postponed until October, but are currently in process.

As of now, delivery is still not reliable. We will likely begin Network Holds sometime in August, the Circulation Department is currently backlogged with returns and curbside, so adding an additional load is not advisable at this point. (Update: We just received 50 bins of materials in delivery today; quarantine until Saturday).
