ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS PUBLIC HEARING, October 19, 2017

The Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on Thursday, October 19, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the Holden Senior Center on the Petition of Stuart Cain and Kristine Yout for property located at 103 General Hobbs Rd. for a VARIANCE for relief from the side yard setback requirements for a pool pavilion.

- R. Spakauskas reviewed the procedures for the hearing and R. Fraser made a motion to waive the reading of the application and the findings of fact; R. Butler seconded and the motion was approved.

Cain stated they had recently installed an in-ground pool and is before the board to ask for relief from the side yard setback requirements to add a pool pavilion as there are not many options to place the pavilion on the property.
