

ATTENTION HOLDEN PROPERTY OWNERS 65 OR OLDER

Did you know that you may qualify for up to \$1000 off your real estate tax bill? A Real Estate Exemption may be available to elderly taxpayers who are record owner(s) of property & who meet certain Income and Whole Estate qualifications.

- * Applicants must be 65 years old prior to **July 1, 2019**, have owned property in Massachusetts for 10 years.
- * Income from all sources in **Calendar Year 2018** must be less than \$20,000 for a single person, or \$30,000 for a married couple.
- * "Whole Estate" which is balances of bank accounts, value of stocks, bonds and other securities as of **July 1, 2019** must be less than \$40,000 for a single person or \$55,000 for a married couple. This does not include the value of your property.

If you think you may qualify, please call the **Assessors Office** at **508-210-5515** between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday; 8:00 a.m.-7:00 p.m. Tuesday and 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Friday. We would be happy to set up an appointment to help you fill out the application.**
