The Zoning Board of Appeals held a public hearing on Thursday, November 19, 2020 at 8:49 p.m. in the Holden Senior Center on the Petition of Sean Xenos for a SPECIAL PERMIT for property located at 649 Bullard St for an accessory apartment.

R. Spakauskas opened the meeting and reviewed the procedures for the hearing. R. Fraser waived the reading of the application and the findings of fact and J. Deignan seconded. A letter was received from the Department of Public Works dated November 10, 2020 reading as follows:

1. A street entry permit shall be approved prior to the commencement of work

2. The applicant shall comply with the Town's updated Stormwater Management Bylaw.

R. Spakauskas then asked the petitioner to address the board. S. Xenos stated he is building a new home for A. Bisson's family and her parents will reside in the accessory apartment to be closer to family.

D. George asked for the accessory apartment to be outlined on the plan for clearer definition.

The Board had no further comments or questions. J. Deignan mad a motion to vote and S. Annunziata seconded. The Board voted in favor, 5-0, UNAMINOUS with the following conditions:

1. Submit the Accessory Apartment plan with the building permit
